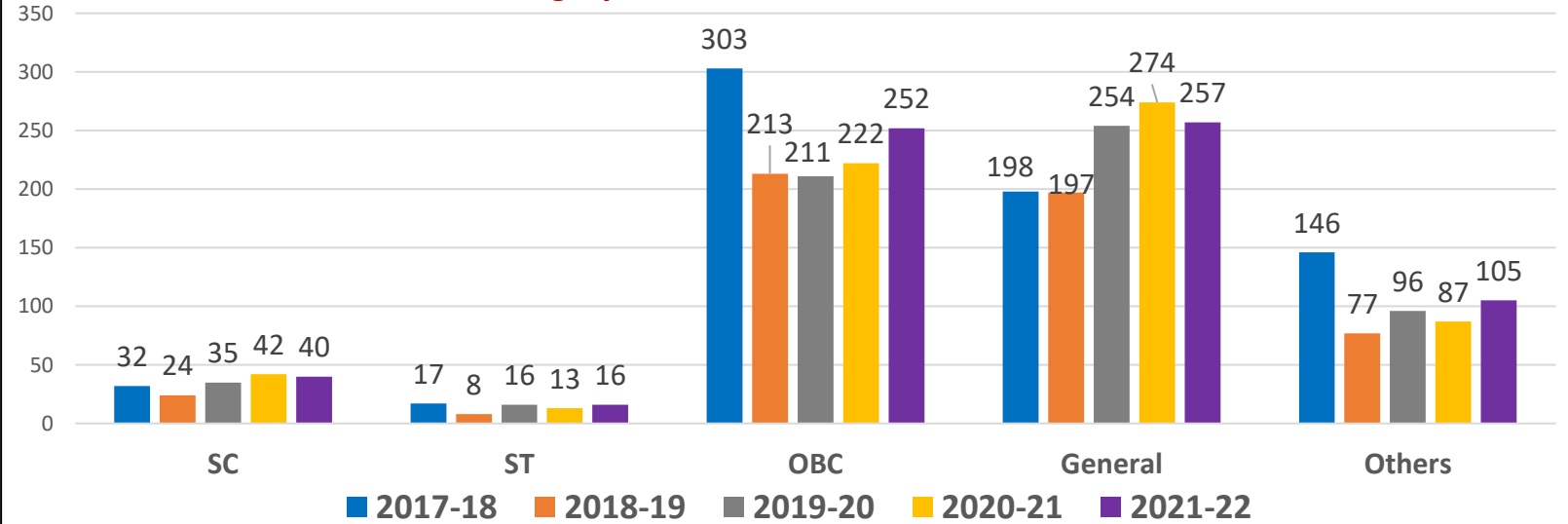

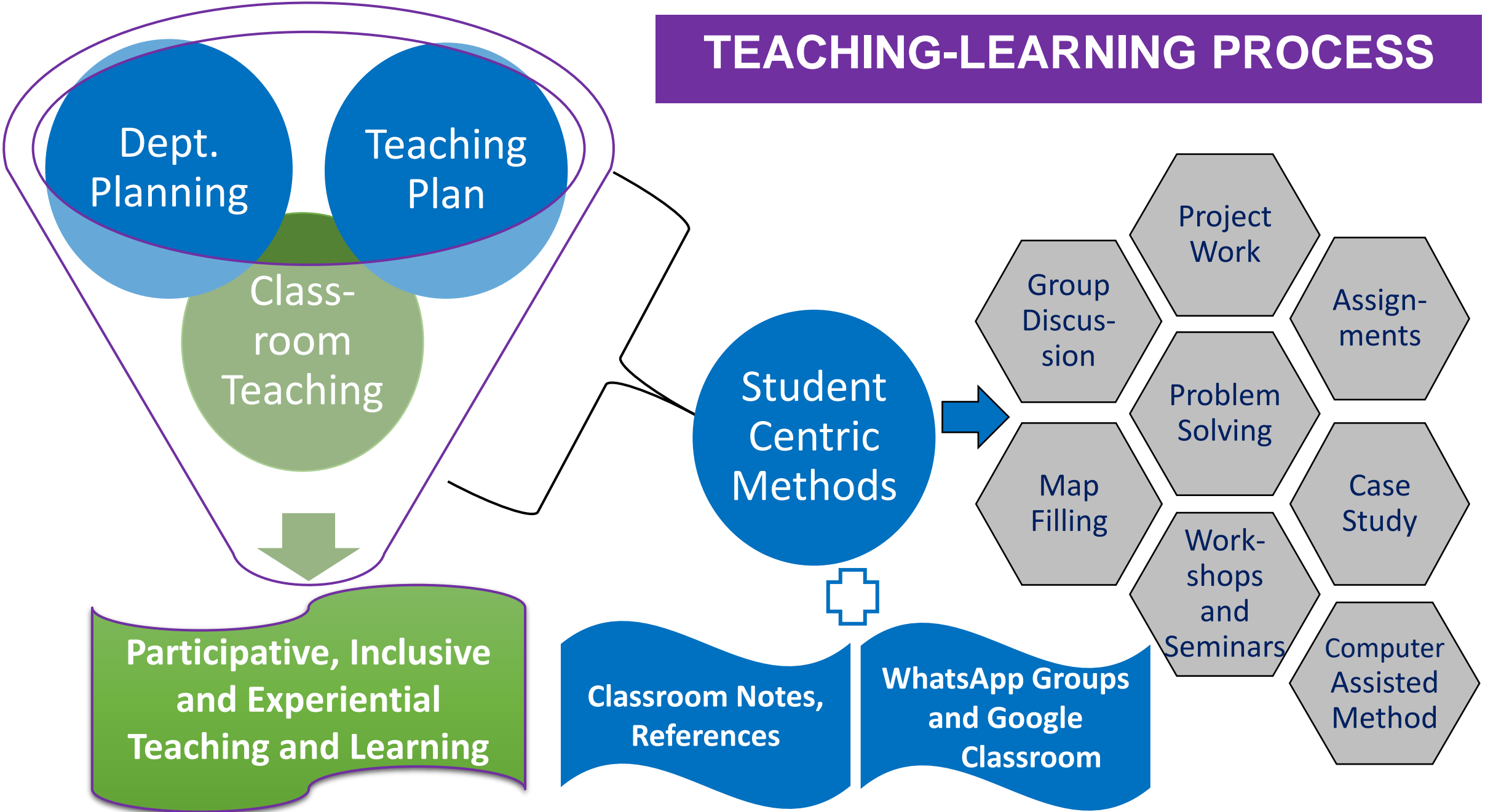

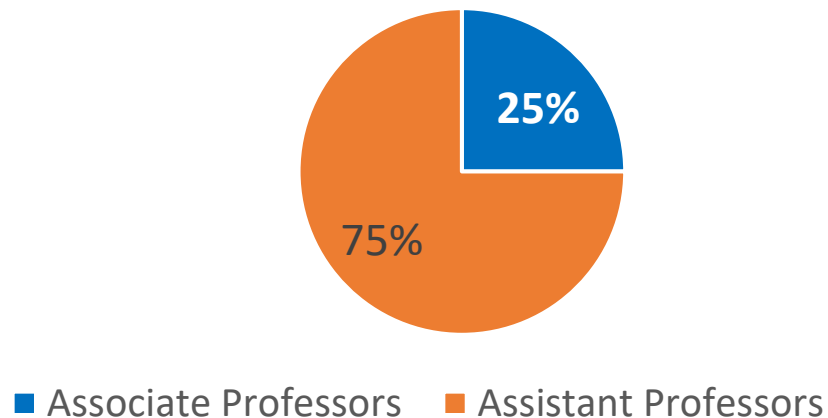
**Stream Wise Profile of Teachers**



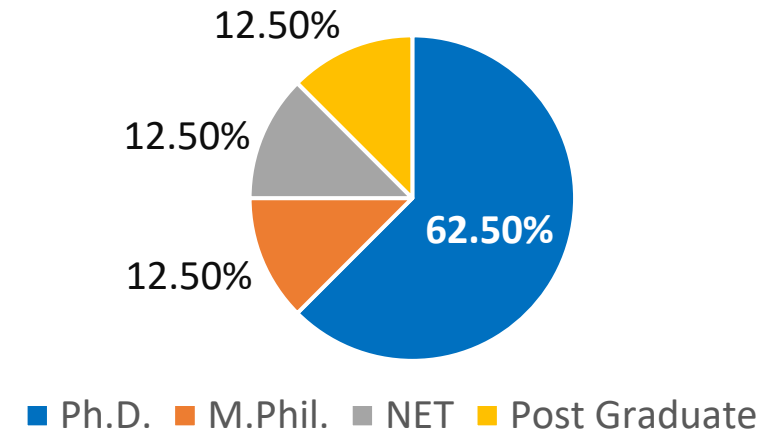
**Gender Profile of Full Time Teachers**



**Designation Wise Profile of Teachers**

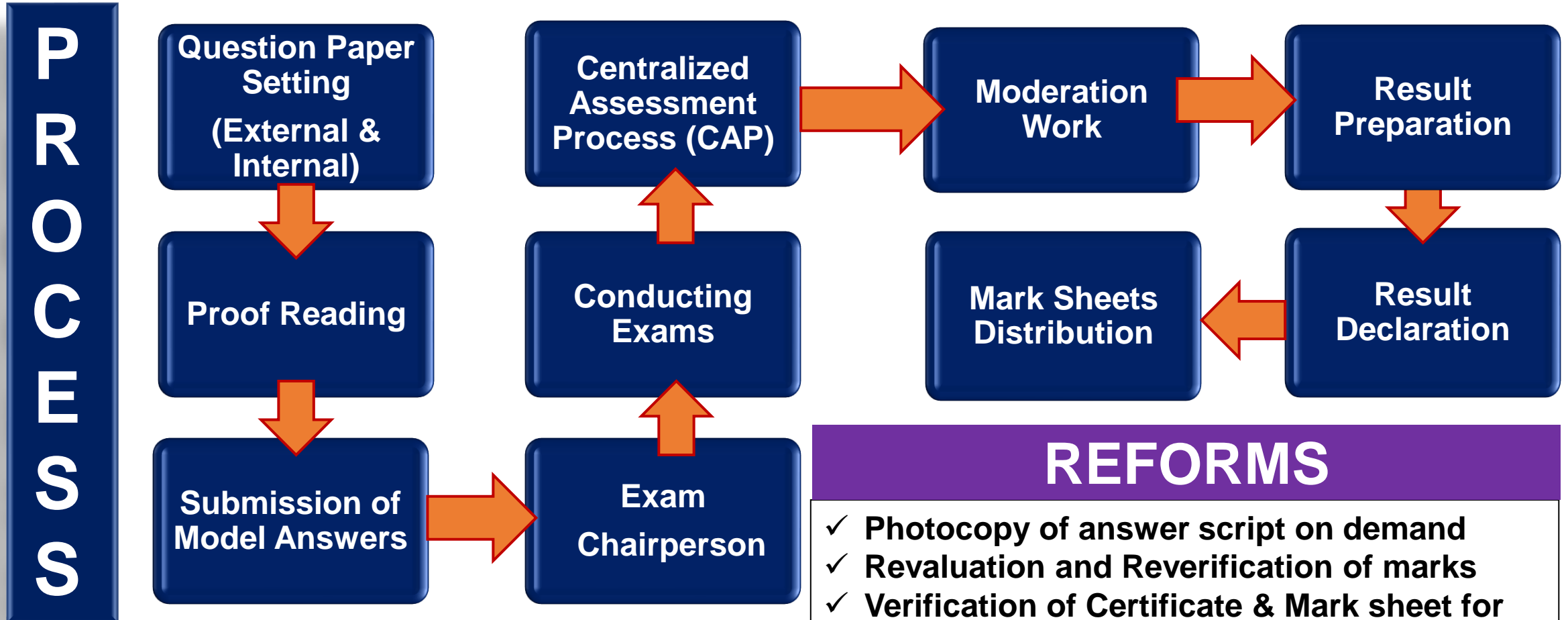

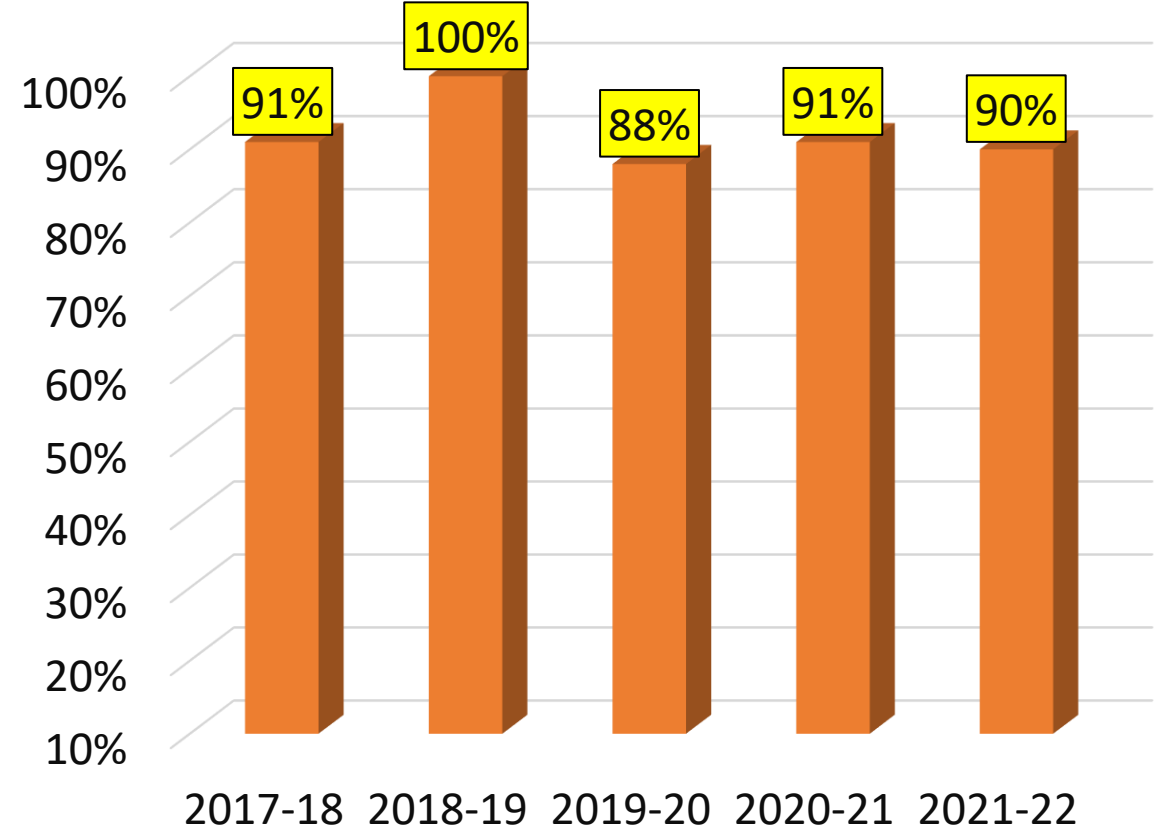

## M.Com. - Accountancy Pass %

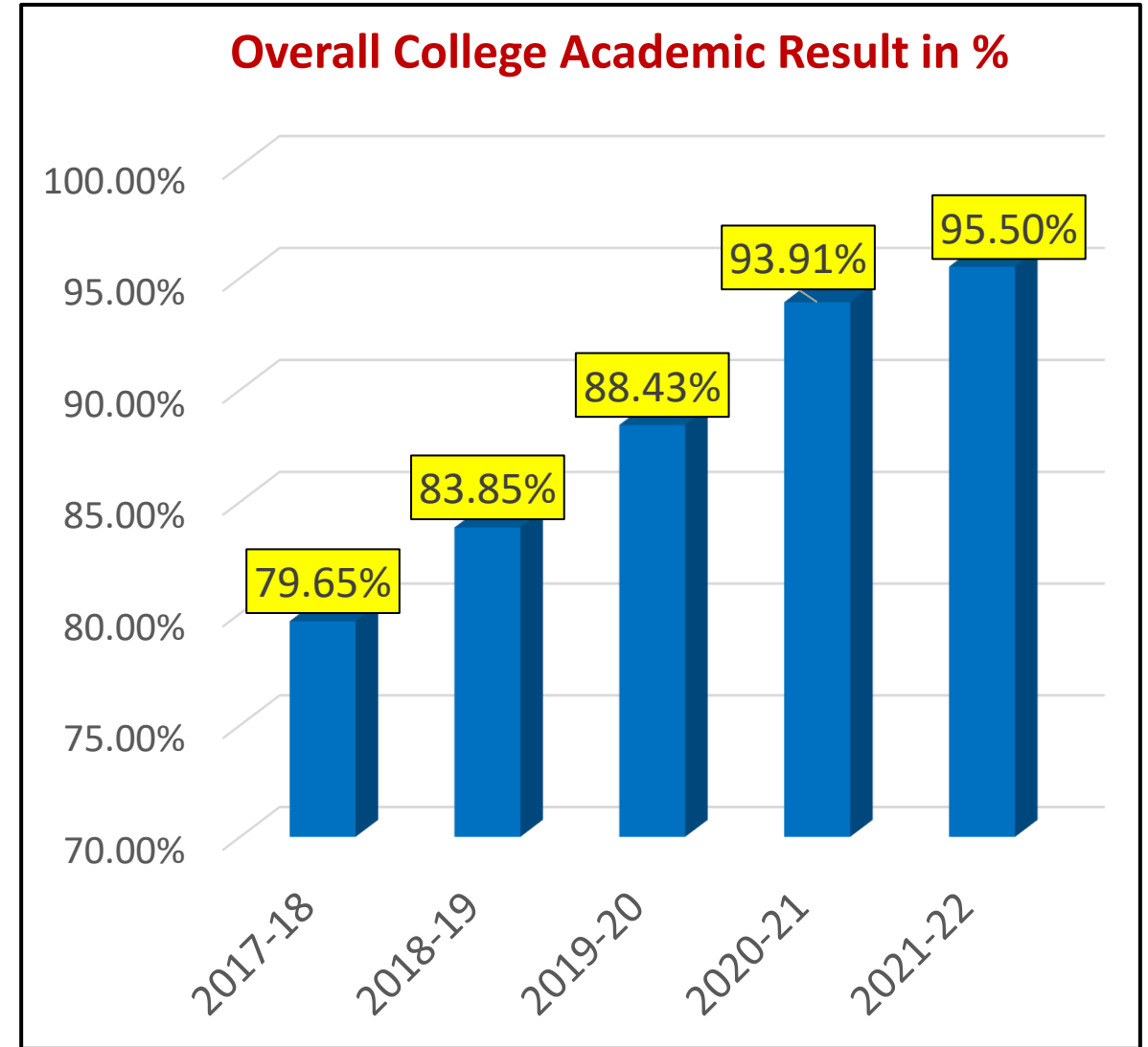
